Resolution # 57 of 2020 Demolition of the Gardy Property

WHEREAS, Chapter 100, "Buildings, Unsafe" Section 100-12, of the Code of the Town of Grafton, "where it reasonably appears that there is present a clear and imminent danger to the life, safety or health of any person or property unless an unsafe building is immediately repaired and secured or demolished, the Town Board may, by resolution, authorize the Building Inspector to immediately cause the repair or demolition of such unsafe building. The expenses of such repair or demolition shall be a charge against the land on which it is located and shall be assessed, levied and collected as provided in Section 100-10" of the Code of the Town of Grafton, and

WHEREAS, the Building Inspector brought to the attention of the Town Board on Wednesday, June 17, 2020 that the ongoing structural deterioration of the Gardy Property on South Road in the Town of Grafton has reached the level of presenting a clear and imminent danger to the life, safety or health of any person or property, and

WHEREAS, the Building Inspector has thus requested that the Town Board authorize him by resolution to immediately cause the demolition of the Gardy Property, pursuant to Chapter 100, Section 100-12 of the Code of the Town of Grafton, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by Resolution #57 of 2020, the Town Board of the Town of Grafton hereby authorizes the Building Inspector to cause the immediate demolition of the Gardy Property.
