Resolution #57 of 2023 RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING MAY 2023 AS MENTAL HEALTH MONTH

WHEREAS, Mental illness will strike nearly one in four adults and children in a given year, regardless of age, gender, race, ethnicity, religion, or economic status; and

WHEREAS, Mental Health Conditions are real and prevalent in our nation and all Americans experience times of difficulty and stress in their lives; and
